Concept Note

Background

The session, “Celebrations of Impact Journey,” aims at putting the spotlights on the impact journey of the Green Campus Program schools that have transformed their conventional campuses into sustainable ones. Green Campus Program (GCP) is one of the flagship programs of The Climate Reality Project – India & South Asia, which is spearheading educational institutes on the path of greener future.
